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**INITIAL TEACHER CERTIFICATION PROGRAM (ITC):**

- ❖ Prerequisites for admission to the **ITC**: At least **9** hours of the **30** upper-division Spanish credits. Students should have completed 18 of the **45** hours in Spanish Major and Related Fields. Those with more credits will be given priority for admission.
- ❖ It is strongly recommended that the requirements in Spanish be fully met before student teaching (**SED 478**). Exceptions will be permitted only upon the express recommendation of the supervisor in Spanish.
- ❖ Two methods courses, required as part of the ITC, are offered through the Department of Languages and Literatures: **FLA 394 (Introduction to Teaching Foreign Languages)**, usually offered in Fall, and **FLA 480 (Methods of Teaching Foreign Languages)**, usually offered in Spring.
