- \_\_\_\_\_ 56 semester hours completed with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- \_\_\_\_\_ MA and SQ requirements must be completed before admission to the PTPP.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sophomore Audition. Should be taken before February in the Sophomore year.
- \_\_\_\_\_ ACT, SAT or PPST completed. and have those scores ready for submission at the time you apply for the PTPP. See General Catalog for minimum scores.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Apply for the PTPP. Should be done by Sept. 15th or Feb. 1st, depending on the semester of intended entry into the PTPP.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete student teaching proficiencies. Should be completed before applying for student teaching.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Apply for student teaching. Should be done by Oct. 15th or Feb. 1st, depending on the intended semester(s) of student teaching.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete the POS 110 and POS 311 requirements or pass the appropriate tests prior to completion of student teaching.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Apply for institutional recommendation for credential. To be done at or near the close of student teaching.
