***NOTES FOR MAJOR:***

- A grade of C or better must be achieved in all courses to be counted toward the major and related fields.
- A minimum of 12 upper-division hours in the major must be taken in residence at ASU Main.
- Pass/Fail courses CANNOT be used for the major or related courses.
- SPA 311 and SPA 312 do not count towards the major in any catalog year.
- SPA 313 and SPA 314 (like SPA 315 and 316) must be taken in sequence.
- SPA 315 and 316 are designed for bilingual students.
- Course substitutions for SPA 313 and 314 (or 315 and 316) are permitted only for native speakers and more advanced students.
- 10 credits of Romanian language courses may substitute for the Portuguese related fields requirement.
