- Completion of 12-15 credit hours of student's academic specialization.
- Sophomore Audition. Should be taken before February in the Sophomore year.
- Completion of the following courses with a "C" or better: ENG 101, ENG 102, MA, SQ/SG or L.
- Completion of at least 56 credit hours by the time the student plans on beginning the ITC program with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Demonstrated experience with the population student plans to teach.
- Apply for student teaching. Should be done by Oct. 15th or Feb. 1st, depending on the intended semester(s) of student teaching.
- Apply for institutional recommendation for credential. To be done at or near the close of student teaching.
