ASIAN STUDIES CONCENTRATION

A concentration in Asian Studies is offered by the Center for Asian Studies. The following minimum requirements must be fulfilled:

1. six to ten semester hours of an Asian language (Chinese, Hindi, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean, Lao, Thai, or Vietnamese);
2. twelve hours of upper division Asian Studies area courses must be chosen from at least two disciplines different from language studies (i.e., History, Geography, Religious Studies, Political Science, etc.).
3. three to six hours of any Asian Studies area courses (lower and upper division hours are acceptable). Three hours may be satisfied with language courses limited to 321 and above.
4. a minimum of "C" in all course work in the concentration.
