Completion of a Nonprofit Minor in the School of Community Resources & Development would require the following:

1. NLM 160, NLM 220
2. 15 hours of graded classroom course work (no internship, no independent study)
3. 9 hours of course work at the upper division level, from the approved list
4. "C" minimum grade required for all classes in the minor
5. Minimum of 9 hours residence credit at ASU Downtown
6. No double counting of courses for both a major and the minor

**Standards:**

1. A minimum GPA of 2.00 for those pursuing the minor
2. A major, or pre-major, other than Nonprofit Leadership and Management
3. Must be a junior to take 400 level courses
