1. PRM 120, PRM 424
2. 15 hours of graded classroom course work (no internship, no independent study)
3. A minimum of 9 hours of course work at the upper division level, from the approved list
4. "C" minimum grade required for all classes in the minor
5. No double counting of courses for both a major and the minor

**Standards:**

1. A minimum GPA of 2.00 for those pursuing the minor
2. A major, or pre-major, other than Parks & Recreation Management or Tourism Development & Management
3. Must be a junior to take 400 level courses
