Students interested in a Dance Minor should consult with a Herberger College of Fine Arts advisor; no audition is required to declare a minor. The Department of Dance offers a minor in Dance consisting of 18 credit hours of course work, including 6 upper division hours. A minimum grade of "C" (2.00) is required in all courses that fulfill the Dance Minor. Students must maintain an overall cumulative GPA of 3.00 for Dance Minor courses. Please note: Courses ordinarily limited to majors only are available to minors on a second-priority basis; that is, minors may not pre-register for these courses, but are allowed to register after all major's needs have been met. Additionally, placement into dance major courses does not constitute acceptance into the dance program. Students who are interested in pursuing a minor and taking major-level technique classes must do several things: (1) obtain a Technique Placement form, which is available in the Department of Dance office, (2) provide a minor DARS report with their major advisor's signature.
