MINOR and BIS CONCENTRATION AREA in ARCHITECTURAL STUDIES

The minor and BIS Concentration Area in Architectural Studies is available to non-architecture majors interested in this field, but who are pursuing another major. A minimum of 18 credit hours is required for the minor or BIS Concentration Area. The courses are designed to provide an overview of architecture throughout history while focusing on architectural design with the intention to explore the process of design thinking.
