

B.I.S. CONCENTRATION (HISTORY) 2001 OR LATER

B.I.S. History Concentration consists of 18 semester hours of course work, at least 12 hours of which are upper division (3xx-4xx). Department of History requires at least a 2.0 GPA (a grade of “C”) for all courses in the concentration. A minimum of 6 upper division hours must be taken at ASU Tempe.

Students are required to complete HST 300 Historical Inquiry and HST 498 Pro-Seminar (HST 300 is a prerequisite for HST 498). The remaining 12 hours of coursework are electives. These 12 hours must be completed within a concentration (geographic or thematic) approved by the History Department.
