- Formal application to the English Department is required for students wishing to complete a Writing Certificate:
  - APPLICATION: <http://www.asu.edu/clas/english/writingprograms/writingcert/>.
  - DEADLINES: Mar. 1 and Oct. 1.
  - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 required.
  - B (3.0) or higher in ENG 101 and 102 (or equivalent first-year composition sequence).
- The student must maintain a 3.0 GPA in all courses taken for the Writing Certificate.
- A minimum of 6 upper-division hours in the concentration must be taken in residence at ASU Tempe.
- The student is required to submit a portfolio prior to receiving the certificate.
