Completion of a Parks and Sustainable Tourism Minor in the School of Community Resources and Development would require the following:

1. PRM 120; PRM 301; PRM 370; PRM 380
2. 15 hours of graded classroom course work (no internship, no independent study)
3. 12 hours of course work at the upper division level, from the approved list
4. "C" minimum grade required for all classes in the minor
5. Minimum of 12 hours residence credit at ASU at the Downtown Phoenix Campus
6. No double counting of courses for both a major and the minor

**Standards:**

1. A minimum GPA of 2.00 for those pursuing the minor
2. A major, or pre-major, other than Nonprofit Leadership & Management, Parks & Recreation Management, and Tourism Development & Management
3. Must be a junior to take 400 level courses
