2. 15 hours of graded classroom course work (no internship, no independent study)
3. 9 hours of course work at the upper division level, from the approved list
4. "C" minimum grade required for all classes in the minor
5. No double counting of courses for both a major and the minor

Standards:

1. A minimum GPA of 2.00 for those pursuing the minor
2. A major, or pre-major, other than Tourism Development & Management
3. Must have completed 56 credit hours to take 400 level courses
