c. Passing scores on appropriate tests

The US and Arizona Constitution requirements must be satisfied for teacher certification but are not required for graduation from ASU's West campus.

#### CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

A minimum of 120 semester hours is required for graduation with a baccalaureate degree from ASU. These must include:

- 50 upper division semester hours
- 30 semester hours MINIMUM at ASU's West campus

Note: 64 semester hours MAXIMUM from community college(s) applicable to B.A.E.

Graduates of an Early Childhood Teaching and Leadership BAE will be eligible for certification in Early Childhood (Birth to 8 yrs of age).
