CONSTITUTION REQUIREMENTS

The US and Arizona Constitution requirements must be satisfied within one year of teacher certification but are not required for graduation from ASU at the West campus. AZ and US Constitution requirements may be fulfilled by any of the following:

POL 417 (AZ)

b. Community college equivalents:

POS 221 (AZ)

POS 222 (US)

POS 220 (US & AZ)

c. Passing scores on appropriate tests.

CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

A minimum of 120 semester hours are required for graduation with a baccalaureate degree from ASU. These must include:

- 50 upper division semester hours
- 30 semester hours MINIMUM at ASU's West campus.

Note: 64 semester hours MAXIMUM from community college(s) applicable to B.A.E.

Graduates of Elementary Education/English as a Second Language Endorsement (ESL) will be eligible for certification in Elementary Education (1-8).
