GENERAL STUDIES (35 hours minimum): All students enrolled in a baccalaureate degree program must successfully complete minimum of 35 semester hours of approved general studies courses. Many General Studies courses are approved as satisfying more than one requirement. The following conditions govern the application of courses toward General Studies requirements:

- 1. A single course may be used to satisfy one core area and a maximum of two awareness area requirements.
- A single course may be used to satisfy a maximum of two awareness area requirements.
- A single course cannot be used to satisfy two core area requirements, even if it is approved for more than one core area

- Completion of secondary education at a school in which the language of instruction is not English or
- Completion of 6 hours of upper division courses that have a Global Awareness (G) or Cultural Diversity (C) designation, in addition to the courses used to meet the University General Studies requirements, or
- Completion of two sequential semesters of course work in a current computer language.
