CORE AREAS: (35 Hours Total)

Literacy and Critical Inquiry (6 hours)

- L PHI 103 Principles of Sound Reasoning
- L NUR 362 Professional Development II: Nursing Research

Mathematical Studies (6 hours)

- MA MAT142 College Mathematics or any MAT course with MA designation

Natural Sciences (8 hours total --at least 4 hours must be SQ)

SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES AND HUMANITIES AND FINE ARTS: Students must take a total of 15 hours (this usually means 5 courses) in Humanities and Fine Arts and Social/Behavioral Sciences--6 hours in one area and 9 hours in the other. Three hours must be upper division. Community College courses and courses from other 2-year schools do not satisfy upper-division requirement.

Awareness Areas (6 hours total): Met by HCR 220 and HCR 230

All three areas are required, and a minimum of two courses is required. A course may satisfy a core requirement (above) and an awareness area simultaneously.

1. Cultural Diversity in the United States (C): HCR 230 Culture And Health
2. Global Awareness (G): HCR 230 Culture And Health
3. Historical Awareness (H): HCR 220 (or HSM) Health Care Organizations

Criteria To Be Considered For Advancement To The Upper Division Nursing Program

1. Admission to ASU as a nursing student in good standing.
2. Minimum Critical Requirement GPA of 2.75.
3. Thirteen (13) Critical Requirement courses completed and enrolled in the last four (4) Critical Requirement courses.
4. Completion of Critical Requirement courses with an earned grade of "C" or higher--in every course.
5. Attendance at a "Workshop on Advancement to Upper Division Courses" (see http://nursing.asu.edu/programs/undergraduate/bsn/appworkshop_schedule.htm).
6. Submission of all required application materials by the following dates:
 - December 1 for fall admission
 - July 1 for spring admission
7. Submission of all health and immunization requirements.
8. Fingerprint clearance.
9. Other material as required (see catalog).

A negative drug screen is required in order to begin the Upper Division Courses.

Earning a BSN from the ASU COLLEGE OF NURSING & HEALTHCARE INNOVATION

(Student assumes full responsibility for meeting all graduation requirements.)

- Meet all University General Studies requirements.
- Meet all degree requirements of the College of Nursing & Healthcare Innovation--56 hours of University General Studies/Critical Requirement coursework, and 64 hours of Upper Division NUR coursework for a total of 120 credit hours.
- **Maximum** of 64 credit hours from community colleges or other two-year schools.
- **Maximum** of 60 credit hours by comprehensive exam.
- 30 credit hours, at **minimum**, taken in residence at ASU.
- 56 letter graded credit hours, at **minimum**, taken in residence at ASU for honors recognition eligibility (e.g. Summa Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude, etc.)
