**CRITERIA FOR GRADUATION FROM ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY WITH A BSN**

**The student assumes full responsibility for meeting all university degree and graduation requirements.**

- Meet all university baccalaureate nursing degree requirements; and
- With a grade of “C” or higher, meet all degree requirements of the College of Nursing and Healthcare Innovation.

**A minimum of 120 credit hours is required to graduate with a baccalaureate nursing degree, consisting of:**

- 45 credit hours minimum must be in upper division coursework from an accredited 4-year academic institution
- 30 credit hours must be taken in residence at Arizona State University
- Not more than 60 credit hours of independent learning and/or comprehensive exams are accepted for credit toward the baccalaureate nursing degree
- Up to 64 credit hours of prerequisite coursework completed at MCCC or from other accredited two-year academic institutions
- A minimum of 56 credit hours must be taken in residence at ASU to qualify for graduation with academic recognition
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 for all courses taken at Arizona State University is required to graduate with a baccalaureate degree
