To be completed within one year of certification:

- a. ASU courses
POS 310 or POS 110 **and** POS 311 or POS 417; **OR**
- b. Community college/transfer equivalents; **OR**
- c. Passing scores on appropriate tests

Three Education Foundations courses, ENG 101 and 102, and 56 credit hours must be complete prior to starting Semester I of the Professional Teacher Preparation Program.

Additional Course Information

Professional Program Prerequisites

Semester I: A total of 56 credit hours must be completed prior to taking Semester I courses, including the following (course equivalents are also acceptable):

*CS General Core requirement

***At least three** of the five Major Requirements/Foundation courses

Semester II: The following prerequisites must be met ***prior to*** taking Semester II courses:

*All Semester I courses and prerequisites

*MA General Core requirement

***ALL** Major Requirements/Foundation courses

Semester III: The following prerequisites must be met ***prior to*** taking Semester III courses:

*All Semester II courses and prerequisites

*SQ/SG General Core requirement

Semester IV: The following prerequisites must be met ***prior to*** taking Semester IV courses:

*All Semester III courses and prerequisites

NOTE:** Because of the intense nature of the student teaching experience, EDC 425 is the ***only course to be taken with Student Teaching (EDC 484);

THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.

*It is expected that students complete all General Core and Academic Specialization courses prior to Semester IV.

Retention and Certification Requirements

*Students must maintain a minimum of 2.5 GPA while enrolled in the Teacher Preparation program.

*A grade of C or better is required in all Education Major Requirements, Academic Specialization, Mathematical, and Science courses.

*A minimum of 120 semester hours is required for graduation with a baccalaureate degree from ASU. These must include:

a. 45 upper division semester hours

b. 30 ASU/ASU East semester hours

*Teacher Preparation students will be required to develop a professional portfolio as part of their program requirements. (Specific information regarding portfolio will be provided upon admission.)

*Graduates of the Teacher Preparation program will be recommended for certification in Elementary Education (K-8).

*Graduation does not guarantee state certification. Students must successfully pass the AZ Teacher Proficiency Assessment and meet all other requirements for certification.
